EDEL 635 is a study of problems in Educational Leadership. You will have following responsibilities:

- 1. Read the text: <u>Case Studies for Educational Leadership: Solving Administrative Dilemmas.</u> Not all cases will covered in individual or group assignments; therefore for the purposes of preparing yourself for the SLLA Examination, reading the entire textbook will be to your advantage. Each student will be assigned a case in which a specific set of assignments will be provided to analyze the case and "Here's What Happened". Responses will be submitted in WebCT/Blackboard
- 2. The instructor will assign "Groups" for case study work (WebCT/Blackboard Groups). There will be specific "Group" assignments for developing ISLLC grading rubrics and then scoring assigned cases from the text where the "Group" will score the assigned cases. Group work will be submitted via WebCT/Blackboard and the Group work will published for the rest of the students to review. Groups will be encouraged to "do" their work via Breeze so that the instructor can document participation of all group members. Other alternative methods for completing group work can be submitted for consideration.
- 3. All students must 3 virtual meetings.
- 4. Each student will participate in the Course Blog. There will be 6 Blog Posts. The instructor will post the topics and each student must respond to each topic (post). This and the virtual meetings will serve as the "attendance" portion of the course grade.
- 5. Each student will participate in the Course Wiki and will make four posts/edits/additions to the Course Wiki.
- 6. Each group must select a "group" project to present at the final class, the format should be PPT and will be presented virtually through Breeze.
- 7. The list of projects will be provided by the instructor and the instructor will approve the topic for the final project.
